TREE ARCHITECTURE WORKSHOP

Białowieża, Poland, October 21-22, 2022

MORPHOPHYSIOLOGY, TREE ASSESSMENT AND TREE MANAGEMENT

Speakers: Giovanni Morelli and Stefania Gasperini

The form of a tree is the expression of the dynamic relationship that binds each tree with the environment in which it grows. The form a tree acquired, however, is not simply a reaction to its environment, but also relies on the principles of tree architecture development.

Giovanni and Stefania will illustrate how these principles change according to the different species and how they evolve following the life of each individual tree. The relationship that links the crown architecture to the organization of the root system will be presented and finally it will be shown how it is possible to relate the architectural characteristics of a tree to biological, physiological and pathological aspects.

Morphophysiology is the discipline that links the tree's architecture with its biological functioning, with reference to its energetic, hormonal and structural aspects. Morphophysiological analysis is based on the predictability of the evolution of a tree. Observations of its present state, allows us to understand its past and foresee its future development. In this way, the most appropriate diagnostic or arboricultural interventions can be designed to positively affect long-term structure.

Case studies on trees and veteran trees will be presented and observations in the field will be conducted.

During the workshop we will proceed with the analysis of the architecture and morphophysiology of some trees in the park. The different stages of development will be described, especially in relation to different botanical species and genera. This analysis will also be the basis for considerations regarding the correct pruning techniques, which must be different according to the tree's stage of development. Specific attention will be paid to the morphophysiological and stability characteristics of veteran trees.

With Giovanni Morelli, Stefania worked for many years with Pierre Raimbault and she now is one of the leaders of Progetto 400, inspired by Francis Hallé, a project that will be studying trees for the next 400 years.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

§ 1 ORGANISER

The organiser of the Tree Achitecture Workshop and accompanying events is Instytut Drzewa sp. z o.o. with its registered seat in Wrocław, entered in the register of entrepreneurs of the National Court Register kept by the District Court for Wrocław-Fabryczna in Wrocław, VI Commercial Division of the National Court Register, under KRS no. § 2 OFFER

1. The Organiser shall carry out the event within the scope and on dates described in detail in the offer available at kongresdrzew.pl
2. The offer specifies: the scope, date, programme and venue of the event, as well as the amount of the participation fee. participation in the event.

§ 3 RULES OF PARTICIPATION

1. Participation in the event is conditional on the availability of free places and on the participant completing an application form available on the Organiser's website no later than 7 working days before the start of the event.
2. The participant is obliged to complete the application form correctly and in accordance with the actual state.

4. Sending the form is tantamount to accepting the conditions of participation contained in these Regulations and has the character of a contract binding both parties to the training.
5. Each registered participant receives during the event a certificate of participation in the training.

§ 4 FEES

1. Payment for participation in the event shall be made on the basis of the registration and the submitted VAT invoice with a fourteen-day payment deadline. The invoice is issued with the date of sale
2. The participant has the option to indicate a different method of payment. The willingness to change must be notified in the notes of the application form. The organiser may introduce discounts for the payment.
3. The organiser may introduce discounts or promotions for the event, in accordance with the terms of the offer.

§ 5 CANCELLATION

1. Cancellation of participation in an event must be made free of charge up to 7 days before the date of the event and must be communicated in writing (by e-mail).
2. Cancellation within a shorter period of time or absence from the event will result in a 50% charge. W In individual cases, lesser costs may be charged.

§ 6 FINAL PROVISIONS

1. The organiser reserves the right, in the event of circumstances beyond its control, to to cancel or postpone the event, of which it will inform the participants at least two weeks
2. In the event that a participant has made a prepayment and is unable to take part in the proposed new date, the Organiser will immediately refund the monies paid.
3. Participants are obliged to familiarise themselves with these Regulations. § 7.PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA
